Statement of Agreement - The **2007-2008 Housing Contract Terms and Conditions** and **ISU Dining Terms and Conditions** are available on the Department of Residence (DOR) Web site at www.housing.iastate.edu. By signing and submitting this contract I am stating that I have read, understood and accept the **Terms and Conditions** and all documents contained therein, including all applicable **Policy Handbooks**.

- I understand that I am entering into a **LEGALLY BINDING** contract with the DOR, contracting for the entire academic year, both fall and spring semesters. I am aware that fall semester only contracts are not available.
- I understand that a \$125.00 prepayment will be added to my university bill. (For new students, the \$125, along with a \$10.00 non-refundable processing fee, is included in the \$275.00 acceptance fee paid to the Office of Admission.)
- I understand that this contract is for a *space* only. Specific assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis, comparing my preference requests to the space that is available. As such, an assignment within my preferences cannot be guaranteed. Priority is determined using the date that my completed contract is received by the DOR. The DOR reserves the right to make changes in assignments when the university deems it necessary.
- I am aware that if I have a documented disability, it is my responsibility to contact the Disability Resources office (515-294-6624) for assistance with housing. For other physical, psychological or cognitive issues that require special accommodation, I will include with this contract a letter of explanation detailing my needs and a statement of medical necessity from my treating physician. All supplementary materials will contain my full name.
- Should I wish to cancel my contract I am aware that all cancellations **MUST BE IN WRITING**, e-mail is acceptable, and must include my full name and University ID. **VERBAL CANCELLATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. I may cancel my contract without penalty until **March 1 for Continuing On-Campus Residents** or **May 1 for New On-Campus Residents**. If I have a contract that begins the spring semester, I may cancel my contract, without penalty, by November 1. As is described in the Terms and Conditions, should I cancel after these dates, I may be responsible for 80% of the value of the Housing and Dining (if applicable) contract plus forfeiture of the prepayment.
- I understand that if I am assigned to Buchanan Hall, Richardson Court or Union Drive I am required to contract for a meal plan. I will initially be assigned a Premium Cy Plan. I am aware that I may change to a different plan for which I am eligible using Access Plus so long as I do so prior to the Friday immediately following the first day of class.
- I verify that the information I am providing on this contract is accurate.
- By signing this contract, I authorize the DOR to access my student educational records maintained by Iowa State University for legitimate business purposes associated with my residing in University Housing. I also authorize the DOR to disclose contact information about me to my assigned roommates including my name, e-mail address, and home address.
- I, the undersigned, guarantee payment of all approved rents and fees for the space assigned to me. The Board of Regents, State of Iowa, will approve room and board rates at its **April** meeting. How Assignments Are Made – Please refer to the DOR Web site, <http://www.housing.iastate.edu/>, for more information regarding this process.

The DOR begins accepting **NEW STUDENT** housing contracts on **July 1** of the prior year (i.e. July 1, 2006 for fall 2007). Your assignment priority is determined using the date that your completed contract is received by the DOR. It is **STRONGLY SUGGESTED** that you submit your housing contract on-line using Access Plus, <https://accessplus.iastate.edu>. Due to the unpredictability of delivery services, the DOR can accept no responsibility for contracts delayed or lost in the mailing process.

Preferences are considered in the following order. Please remember that this contract is for a *space* only, and not for a particular building or assignment type. Specific assignments are made on a first-come, first-served basis, comparing preference requests to the space that is available. As such, an assignment within your preferences cannot be guaranteed.

1. **Learning Community (LC)** preferences are considered first, above all else. Most LCs have eligibility requirements and you **MUST** be eligible for the LC you have selected (http://www.housing.iastate.edu/residential_learning_communities.php). If you are not eligible for the LC you have selected, or if the LC is full when we make your assignment, we will use your other preferences (pages 3 and 4) to make your assignment. If you have selected an LC and indicated a roommate request, your roommate request can only be considered if space is available, the roommate request is mutual and your roommate is also eligible for and has preferred the same LC.
2. **Roommate Requests** are considered next. All roommate requests must be mutual; that is you each must have requested the other. The room preferences of all roommates do not need to match, but you must all be eligible for the same type of housing (page 4). The earliest contract date is used to determine priority for the roommate group. Roommate requests are determined to take priority over all other Room Preferences. We will use the Room Preferences you have indicated to guide us in accommodating your roommate request; however, your assignment may be to any campus location where your request can be accommodated. If you also answered "Yes" to the Single Room preference (page 4), please know that you will only be considered for a single room if we are not able to accommodate you with your roommate in any area of campus for which you are eligible.
3. We will next consider your **Single Room** preference. If you answer "Yes" to this question, and you are also eligible for Union Drive and Richardson Court (page 4), we will try to assign you to a traditional single room in these neighborhoods. Requests for single rooms are determined to take priority over all other Room Preferences. We will use the Room Preferences you have indicated to guide us in making your single room assignment; however, your assignment may be to any single room in the Union Drive or Richardson Court neighborhoods. **PLEASE NOTE:** Single Rooms are very limited and not everyone who requests a single room can receive one.
4. Finally, we will consider your **Room Preferences**. We ask that you list up to eight (8) preferences. If you list less than eight preferences and we are not able to accommodate you in those preferences, we will be forced to make our best guess as to your assignment. **PLEASE NOTE:** While it varies from year to year, some of the more popular options, such as Eaton, Friley, Maple and Martin Halls, fill with early contract dates, often as early as two months after the date we begin accepting contracts. It is strongly recommended that you consider preferencing at least one (1) option outside of these areas.

Roommate Requests and Family Housing Occupant Listing

If you are assigned to a multiple occupancy room and you do not list a roommate request, a roommate will be assigned to you. Additionally, if you are assigned to SUV and you do not request to keep the apartment to yourself, a roommate will be assigned to you.

Single Room - A limited number of single rooms are available in Oak, Elm, Birch, Barton, Linden, Lyon, Freeman, Welch, Roberts and Friley halls.

Neighborhood Eligibility Requirements

In order to be eligible to live in on-campus housing, individuals must be in good financial standing with ISU and must meet one of the following criteria:
 (1) the individual must be enrolled as a student at ISU; or
 (2) the individual must be registered and enrolled in the Admissions Partnership Program, offered through ISU and DMACC.

Age eligibility is determined as of August 1, 2007 for contracts that begin fall and January 1, 2008 for contracts that begin spring. Additional eligibility requirements for specific neighborhoods are as follows:

◆ Union Drive and Richardson Court	Newly admitted, direct from high school students; transfer students 19 or younger; continuing undergraduate students.
◆ Buchanan and Wallace Halls ◆ Frederiksen Court Apts. ◆ University Village Apts. (SUV Single Student Housing)	Newly admitted students 19 or older; transfer students; continuing students. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Buchanan Hall also houses the EILC Learning Community and has two floors dedicated to graduate students or students 21 or older*. • University Village also houses those individuals classified as Post Docs.
◆ Schilleter Village Apts. (SUV Family Housing)	Any student married or in a domestic partner relationship and/or with custody/visitation rights for dependent children; the student's spouse/domestic partner and/or dependent children
